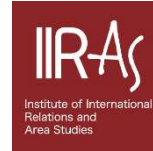

Dr. Shogo Suzuki is a Senior Lecturer (Associate Professor) at the Politics Department of the University of Manchester, UK. He received his Ph.D. from the Australian National University. Shogo Suzuki has research interests in International Relations Theory with reference to East Asia, as well as Chinese and Japanese Foreign Policy and Sino-Japanese Relations.

He has published in these topics in a range of journals, including European Journal of International Relations, Third World Quarterly, International Affairs, The Pacific Review, and the Journal of Contemporary China. He is also the author of Civilization and Empire : China and Japan’s Encounter with European International Society, and is the editor (with Yongjin Zhang and Joel Quirk) of International Orders in the Early Modern World.
